

Spring 2012 Officials Proposal:

The current MWPA policy states:

- A. *Officials shall be compensated as follows:*
 - 1. *Regular Season – Dual Games: \$36 Varsity Game, \$29 Junior Varsity Games. (Single officials to receive double pay) - Recommended*
 - 2. *Regular Season – Tournaments: Pay determined by individual tournament directors.*
 - 3. *Post Season Tournaments – Officials will be paid by the MWPA:*
 - a. *District Championship Tournaments: \$30 per game, \$10 per game for goal judges, \$50 stipend for head official.*
 - b. *Regional Championship Tournaments: \$40 per game, \$10 per game for goal judges, \$50 stipend for head official*
 - c. *State Championship Tournament: \$50 per game, \$10 per game for goal judges, \$200 stipend for Director of Officials.*
 - 1. *Goal judges will be assigned for all games played at the District, Regional and State Championship Tournaments.*
- B. *Active coaches will not be allowed to officiate during their respective seasons. This rule pertains to all coaches, assistant coaches, and team managers. The only exception to this rule would be the officiating of contests at a JV tournament where their team is not participating in any games officiated by the individual in question.*

Change the policy as follows effective for the Boys 2012 Fall Season:

- A. *Officials shall be compensated as follows:*
 - 1. *Regular Season – Dual Games: **\$41 Varsity Game, \$34 Junior Varsity Games. (Single officials to receive \$85)***
 - 2. *Regular Season – Tournaments: **\$30 for JV Tournaments or \$35 for Varsity Tournaments***
 - 3. *Post Season Tournaments – Officials will be paid by the MWPA:*
 - a. *District Championship Tournaments: **\$35 per game**, \$50 stipend for head official.*
 - b. *Regional Championship Tournaments: **\$45 per game**, \$50 stipend for head official*
 - c. *State Championship Tournament: **\$55 per game**, \$10 per game for goal judges, \$200 stipend for Director of Officials.*
 - 1. *Goal judges will be assigned for all games played at the State Championship Tournaments.*
- B. *Active coaches will not be allowed to officiate during their respective seasons. This rule pertains to all coaches, assistant coaches, and team managers. The only exception to this rule would be the officiating of contests at a JV tournament where their team is not participating in any games officiated by the individual in question.*
